Vera Nechaeva was born in 1970 in Tashkent, Uzbekistan. Floral bouquets play a prominent role in the works of the artist. Nature appears in Nechaeva's still-lives in the vivid brilliance and forceful intensity. The spectrum of the blossoms extend from vibrant yellows to a various tones of orange and red. The distortion of form are employed as artistic means to attain a dense composition. The flower heads, grouped together in a space, generate an intensively colorful image. Colour and technique conveys a painter's character and is an expression of joy and a sign of hope.
